against the inhuman and illegal treatment given by the police to the prisoners, criminals, and common citizens.

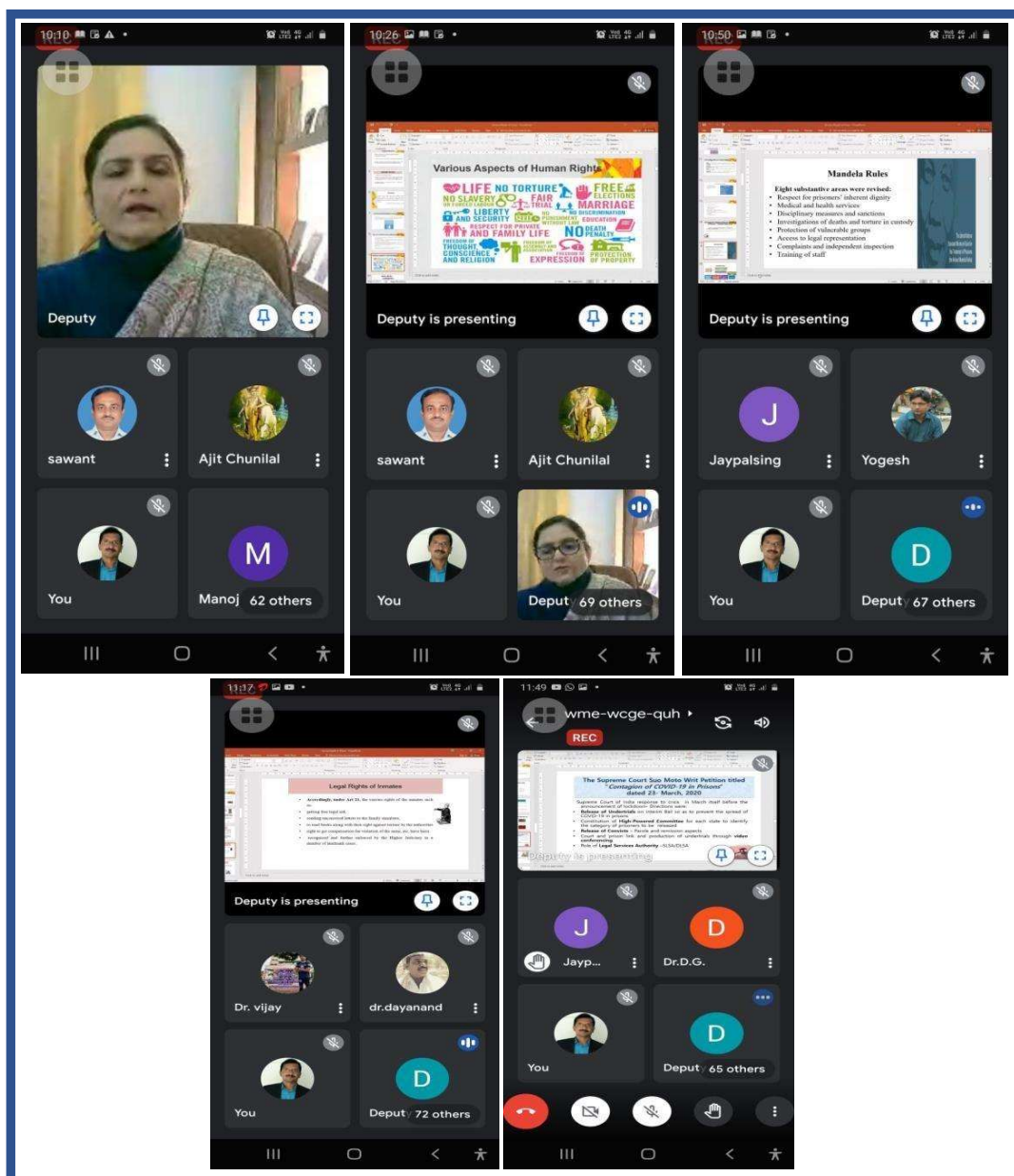
